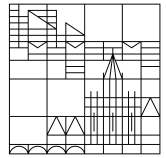
In line with the multidisciplinary character of the Zukunftskolleg, the program is open to young researchers in **all faculties** of Konstanz University.

### Aims of the interdisciplinary scientific research grant

The new funding programme aims to promote research collaborations between young researchers. An interdisciplinary research project gives grant holders the opportunity to identify and explore new, innovative and/or risky research perspectives with neighbouring disciplines and across disciplines. The grant should facilitate expert-intensive and inspiring research and offer recipients the chance to work together with colleagues from different disciplines, as well as to develop cross-cutting methods and topics.

The grant may cover consumables, staff (student assistants) or the costs for a scientific retreat.

Young researchers from all faculties of Konstanz University and fellows of the Zukunftskolleg are invited to apply by **January 31, 2017**.

## Application

Applications must contain:

- A description of the scientific objectives that clearly states the interdisciplinary nature of the scientific project (max. 6 pages)
- A work plan
- An expenditure plan (**the money has to be spent until October 31, 2017**)
- CVs of the principal investigators involved in the research project (maximum length 3 pages per principal investigator).

At the end of the project, we expect a final report on how the project goals were or were not achieved.
